

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MEETING

RECONSTRUCTION OF

ST. HELENA ROAD BRIDGE OVER DEAD CREEK TOWN OF HUSTISFORD

September 26, 2023
7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

The reconstruction of the St. Helena Road Bridge over Dead Creek will be discussed at a public involvement meeting scheduled by the Town of Hustisford in Dodge County, Wisconsin.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 26th, 2023 from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Hustisford Town Hall located at N3906 County Road EE, Neosho, WI 53059. The meeting will also have a link available on the Town of Hustisford website to attend virtually. Residents and heavy route users are encouraged to attend via whichever format works best for them.

The Town of Hustisford will replace the existing St. Helena Road bridge with a new single-span concrete flat slab bridge in Section 07, T10N, R16E. The roadway approaches will be reconstructed. Work will consist of bridge removal, grading, concrete masonry, crushed aggregate base course, asphalt pavement, guardrail, erosion control items, and landscaping items.

During construction, St. Helena Road will be closed at the bridge. Work is scheduled to take place in the summer of 2025.

The purpose of the meeting is to present the preliminary plans for the bridge construction project, discuss the proposed schedule, and gather public input. Upstream floodplain impacts due to the computed minor increase in flood stage will be discussed. Any comments that may be of interest to the design team are welcome.

The meeting will be organized in an open-house format and interested persons are invited to attend at their convenience. There will be a presentation at the onset to provide an overview of the projects followed by questions. Representatives from Dodge County, the Town of Hustisford, WisDOT, and Ayres will be available to discuss the design details, address comments, and answer questions. Displays showing the proposed project will be available for viewing.

Persons with a concern or knowledge about the floodplain, historic buildings and structures, public lands, and archaeological sites are encouraged to attend this meeting or provide comments to the Town of Hustisford.
